To Whom it may concern,

Effective 3/14/24, East Hawaii Health Cancer Center will be limiting the acceptance of new patient referrals in Hematology due to a high volume of patients. A quality initiative that EHHCC is undertaking is to ensure that we can safely treat our current patient population. To achieve this, it has been decided that EHHCC will temporarily limit new consultations. Certain benign hematology patients or patients with blood disorders caused by non-malignant conditions will temporarily not be scheduled for appointments.

These conditions include:

1. Anemia due to chronic disease
2. Anemia secondary to CKD
3. Iron deficiency anemia controlled on oral iron
4. Idiopathic thrombocytopenic purpura (ITP) in remission normal platelet counts
5. Neutropenia
6. Thalassemia
7. Thrombocytopenia
8. Pancytopenia
9. Blood clots, DVT
10. Monoclonal Gammopathy of Undetermined Significance (MGUS)
11. *Hemophilia- Refer to hemophilia center: Kapiolani Hospital, Oahu*

-The Hemophilia Clinic is held on the first and third Thursday of every month.

-Appointments are scheduled at 9 a.m., 10 a.m., 11 a.m., 1 p.m., 2 p.m. and 3 p.m.

-The Coagulation Clinic is held on the second and fourth Thursday of every month.

-Appointments are scheduled at 9 a.m., 10 a.m. and 11 a.m.
